This well preserved guest house, a secondary structure to 6533 Bayou Hammock Rd has received minimal alterations, excepting the gable additions and partial window replacement. Nonetheless, it is typical of many Frame Vernacular dwellings on LBK and does not appear to be N.R. eligible.
