This early frame Ranch style residence was one of the first of three homes constructed in Bayou Hammock, which was developed by Gordon Whitney. It retains most of its historic architectural integrity, but is similar to a number of other post WW II houses on LBK. Thus, it does not appear to be N.R. eligibe.
