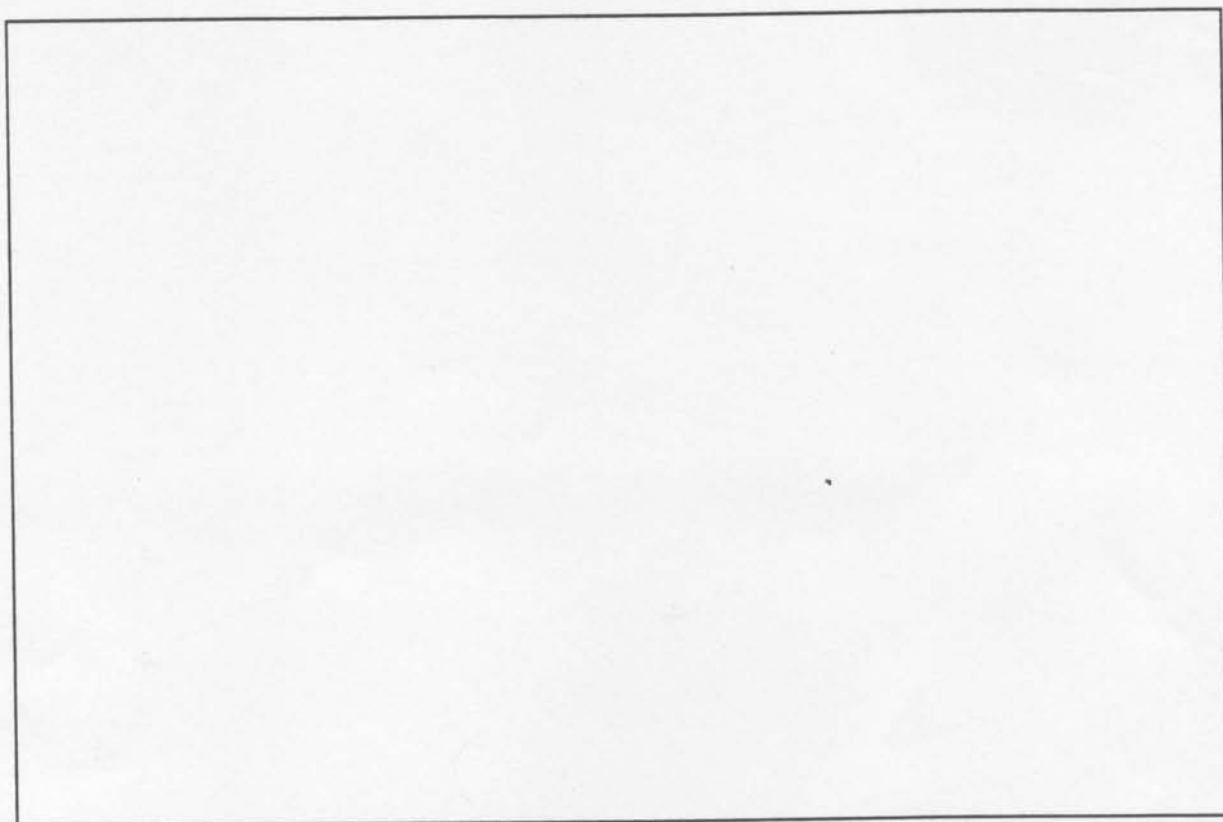

STREET OR PLAT MAP

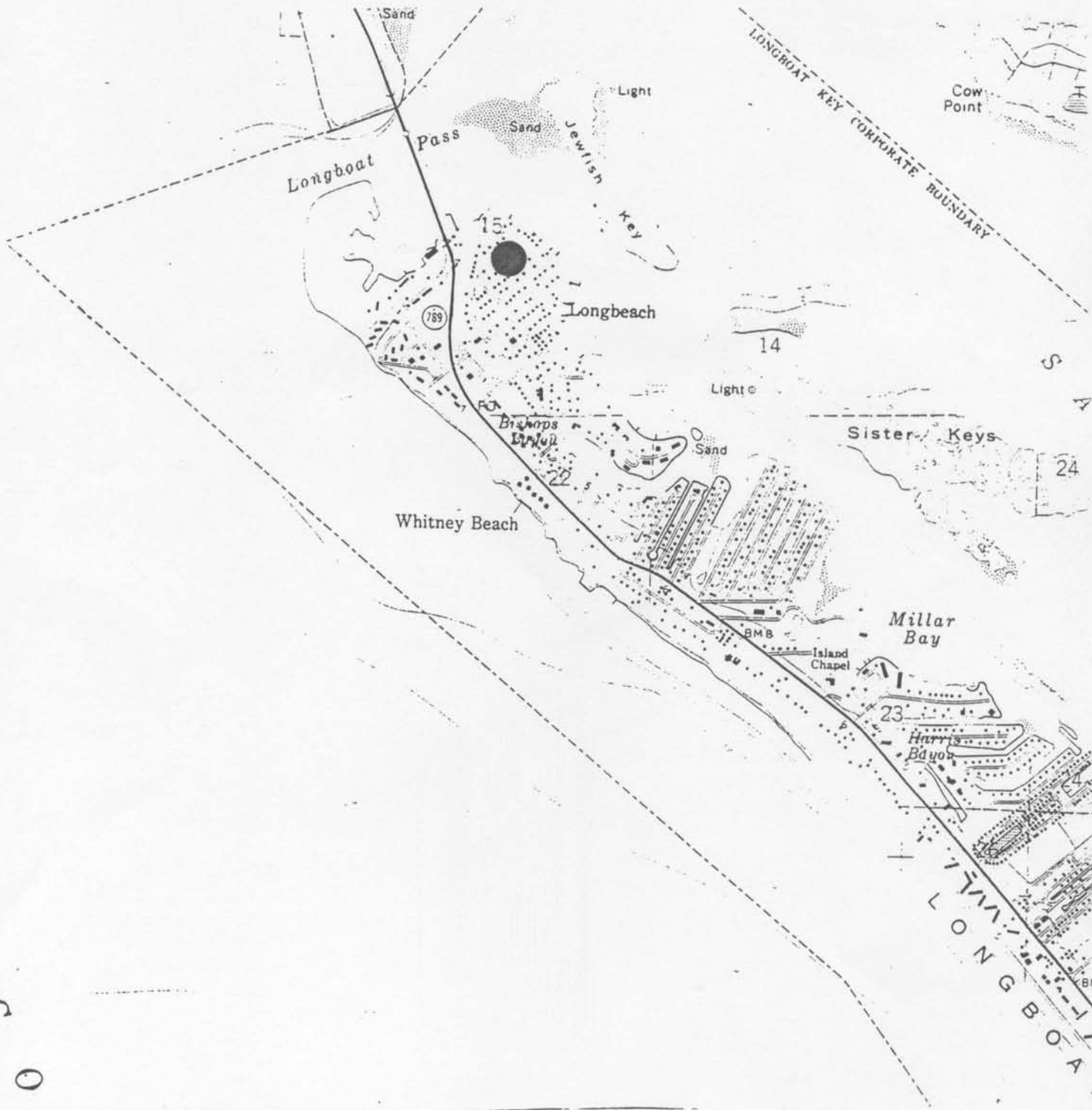
